The "other assets" are believed to be parcels the HNYLDC purchased then merged into the FedEx parcel and have not been accounted for. Total assets equal \$1,979,317.85.

Executive Director Update:

- -HNYLDC has been awarded the \$250,000 Fast Grant from New York State for the Crossroads site. The grant will fund the HNYLDC moving through the process of "pre-permitting" the land making it more marketable to buyers as they can purchase and go right to building process foregoing the Planning Department. Once the grant paperwork is received Doyle will have a resolution authorizing him to sign the agreement.
- -Doyle is working on bids to do some clearing at the Crossroads site and it has been a bit of a struggle to get comparable bids and find companies to do the clearing. The board said a formal Request for Proposal should be written outlining exactly what needs to be done including time and material not to exceed specific dollar amount.
